Hot on the heels of the Dandelion Records Singles Collection boxset we continue our programme of re-issuing classic records from the revered label's diverse and intriguing catalogue. February sees the re-release of 'New Bottles, Old Medicine' (CDMRED314), the debut album from atmospheric folk-rockers Medicine Head, whilst we are currently in the process of piecing together our next box set. With a working title of "Kevin Coyne: The Dandelion Years" (CRCDBOX2), this will feature the entire Dandelion output from one of our best-loved British blues artists, inc. his work with Clague/Coyne and Siren.



March will get your taste buds tingling with the release of "You've Gotta Hand It To 'Em: The Very Best Of The Waltonnes" (CDMRED308), featuring the entire musical works of the mid-80's Manchester indie-sceners. Guitarist Mark Collins soon went on to achieve fame and fortune with the Charlatans, in fact, he's still with them! This month also heralds the release of "Let's Get The Hell Back To Lubbock: The Very Best Of Terry & Gerry" (CDMRED312), the complete collection from the country's greatest political romanticism skiffle combo and one-time residents of Marc Riley's In-Tape label.



The Goth Collectors Series is truly un-dead and kicking with two releases planned for the first part of 2007. 'All Tomorrows Parties' Nico Live (CDMGOTH25), is a fascinating 2xCD album from the late Queen of punk-rock, whilst we finally unleash the 3rd album from the Danse Society "Looking Through" (CDMGOTH26).

Cherry Red has moved from strength to strength this year with an ever increasing catalogue and new labels under its wing. 2006 has seen some very well received releases in the likes of Glaxo Babies (CDMRED291), Dead Kennedys' 25th Anniversary edition of Fresh Fruit (CDS-BRED300) as well as our ongoing Toyah, Jim Bob and Dandelion Records series, the latter of which recently culminated in the critically acclaimed release 'Life Too Has Surface Noise: The Complete Dandelion Singles Collection 69-72 (CRCDBOX1).

The first ever DVD to feature on of the Indie-Rock acts to emerge from Ireland in the 1990's, The Sultans Of Ping FC formed in early 1989, based in Cork, Ireland. In 1991 Martin Heath of Rhythm King Records catches their live set by accident and promptly offers them a deal.

"Where's Me Jumper" was the band's first single in January 1992 and it became a cult classic - the biggest selling single of that year in Ireland, beating off competition from Bryan Adams "Everything I Do". The Sultans release two further singles that year "Stupid Kid" and "Veronica" which strengthen the band's profile even more.

The band split in the mid-1990's, but their enduring appeal to their loyal fanbase forced a reunion in late 2005 with shows in the UK and Ireland.

"U Talk Too Much" (CRDVD145) features a show from the reunion tour in the band's hometown of Cork - a stunningly good live experience featuring all of their classic hit songs.

As well as the Rev-Ola, RPM, EI, Lemon, Anagram and Delay 68 labels (to name a few!), Cherry Red has welcomed a host of new labels to the fold in the shape of Giant Steps, Mortahate, Five Four, Ork and Repressed who have been quick in establishing themselves alongside the rest of the Cherry Red family.

For El 2006 has been a year when the characters intrinsic to the imprint was allowed to emerge; the matters of style that set these labels apart from their contemporaries.

The new El has an historic emphasis but what prevents it from being run-of-the-mill is an (almost) precocious ecelecticism that is unique and-at a time when the industry is perhaps wary off being too bold-a real strength.



2006 started with Ravi Shankar's re-assuringly psychedelic 'Transmigration Macabre' and the best Cowbills edition and that sense of playful contradiction was maintained throughout the year; Orson Welles and Jack Wild. Antonio Carlos Jobim and Erik Satie. The Four Freshmen and Brigitte Bardot. John Cage and Caterina Valente. Sylvia Telles and Nara Leao. A label made in heaven.

Now that the charts are meaningless, the public is liberated to create it's own musical environment, free from the constraints of fashion. Quite an exciting prospect.

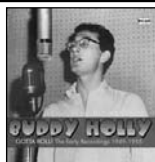

2006 has been another bumper year of DVD releases from Cherry Red Films, once again encompassing a wide range of music and special interest genres.

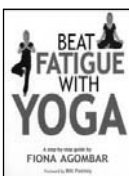

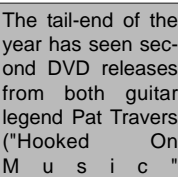


The second quarter of the year also produced successes in the shape of the first ever DVD to feature US alt-rockers

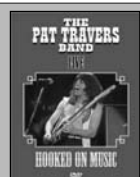

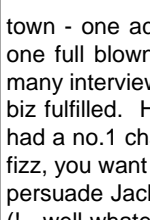
The first music DVDs came through with the Glen Campbell and Andy Williams programmes hitting the shops as I write; an almost mythical Joe Meek produced album came through in the Charles Blackwell Orchestra LP ; a slow burner in former Orlon, Rosetta Hightower's LP for production library Rediffusion finally catching flame sales wise is very pleasing (follow ups are planned in her 1970 CBS LP, and hubby Ian Greens two cracking 70's funky rock LPs 'Revelation' and 'Seven Ages of Ma'n - both with Hightower's vocal backing) ; the follow up to our foray into Apple Music Publishing songs finally made it after a two year gestation, called 'An Apple A Day' - but certainly worth the wait especially those unreleased Gallagher and Lyle tracks and more unreleased lveys ; then there was that extraordinary week of May 21-26 when the legendary Jackie DeShannon was in town - one acoustic show, one Mojo Awards launch show, one full blown electric show, the Ivor Novellos Awards and many interviews later I reasoned I could retire from the music biz fulfilled. Having said that, it is as they say when you've had a no.1 chart hit, when the champagne bubbles cease to fizz, you want it to have it again. So maybe next year we can persuade Jackie another UK show is essential to her career (! - well whatever works).

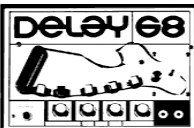

ORK has just kicked off with The Babys, the UK power pop outfit who in the mid 70's infamously inked a seven figure record deal with Chrysalis off the back of rehearsals alone. A steady release programme for next year is planned for both labels, with ORK being first out of the blocks with legendary Scottish heavy rock band The Writing On The Wall. A first time reissue of the 'Power Of The Picts' LP plus a second bonus disc of unreleased gems (including the full 6 min 40secs version of 'Buffalo').

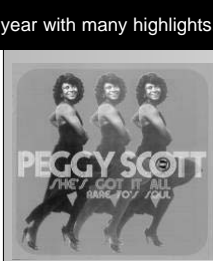


DELAY 68 RECORDS

2006 has been another great year for Delay 68 Records, and sister label Finders Keepers Records. Delay 68 has 3 new titles to it's name - the follow up to last years

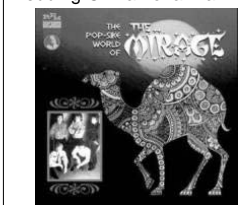

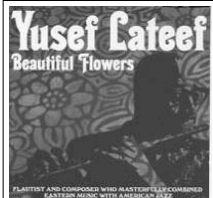

JAZZ FROM FIVE FOUR / GIANT STEPS



Cherry Red made it's first foray into the world of Jazz this year with the brand new Five Four Records, headed by Els Mike Alway, and the world renowned Giant Steps.

The FiveFour label set out it's own exciting global eclecticism that would embrace Yusef Lateef, Sun Ra and Laurindo Almeida but the editions involving the work of Johnny Smith, Ahmad Jamal and the late Django Reinhardt sessions achieve a level of artistry that is sensitive and profound. Expect fivefour to grow further over the coming months.



Giant Steps joined the Cherry Red family in the Spring and has already established itself as one of the labels leading lights. With a solid catalogue featuring some of the biggest names in jazz, Giant Steps has garnered both critical and commercial success with releases from such legends as Jimmy Giuffre, Dizzy Gillespie, Ronnie Scott and The Gerry Mulligan Quartet. With a comprehensive back-catalogue reissue programme in process and a slew of new releases in the pipeline, Giant Steps is one to watch in 2007.

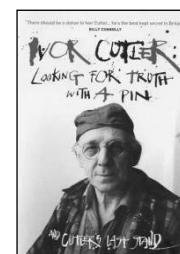
